## **2D Stokes Problem With a Moving Contact Line**

We consider the evolution of a two--dimensional liquid droplet on a solid subtrate in the presence of a contact point. At the liquid-solid interface we assume Navier slip. At the triple point we assume a constant contact angle, given by Young's law. The main result is well--posedness and regularity of the solution in a class of weighted Sobolev space
